### **OFFICER RECOMMENDATION**

#### That the Council

- 1. receive the petition requesting that the Council abandon plans to relocate the Busselton War Memorial (War Memorial) and Memorial Wall to Rotary Park and seeking
  - (a) that the War Memorial be restored to its original state, and
  - (b) that the City supports the heritage listing of the War Memorial Site.
- 2. notes that the relocation of the War memorial is the subject of item 14.1 of this meeting agenda.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

A Petition (the Petition - Attachment B with personal information redacted) and cover letter (Attachment A with personal information redacted) was received from the Petitioners on 7 November 2022 requesting as follows:

We, the undersigned, do respectfully request that the Council:

Abandon the plans forthwith of the relocation to Rotary Park (a former tip site) of the Busselton War Memorial and Memorial Wall. That the \$340,000, set aside for the relocation, is used to restore the oldest War Memorial In WA, built in 1919, to Its original state and note the Memorials (Obelisk and Wail) are owned by the City (not the RSL) and therefore the community. It should also be noted the historic plaques to Busselton's founder John Garrett Bussell and Phoebe Bower, are located in this area.

Further that the City supports the heritage listing of the Site to ensure its retention in the future.

The requirements for a petition to be heard by Council is set out by Standing Order 6.9 of the *City of Busselton Standing Orders Local Law 2018*, specifically that it:

- (a) be addressed to the Mayor;
- (b) be made by electors of the district;
- (c) state the request on each page of the petition;
- (d) contain the name, address and signature of each elector making the request;

- (e) contain a summary of the reasons for the request;
- (f) state the name of the person to whom, and an address at which, notice to the petitioners can be given; and
- (g) be respectful and temperate in its language.

The Presiding Member has the discretion to accept the Petition for consideration if it meets a majority of the above requirements. The Petition meets all of the requirements, noting that while the cover letter is addressed to the Acting CEO, each page of the Petition is addressed to the Mayor. The Petition contains 244 signatures.

Pursuant to Standing Order 6.9(3), the Council then has the following options:

- (a) receive the petition;
- (b) reject the petition;
- (c) receive the petition and refer it to the CEO to prepare a report to Council / Committee;
- (d) receive the petition and refer it to the CEO for action.

The relocation of the Busselton War Memorial is the subject of Item 14.1 on this same agenda for the 16 November 2022 Council meeting. The recommendation of Item 14.1 is that the Council endorse the concept designs for the potential relocation of the War Memorial to Rotary Park (as presented) for the purposes of further community engagement, and, on completion of the community engagement, request the CEO present a report to the Council for a final determination on the relocation.

Given the recommendation for further community engagement and a further report to Council post that, it is recommended that the Petition be received by the Council.

RE; Community Petition submission Objecting to the intended relocation of the Historical Busselton War Memorial

Please find enclosed signed petitions objecting to the subject intended relocation of the Historical Busselton War Memorial.

The Community petition contains two hundred and forty five signatures at this stage and is forwarded to the Busselton City Council for records and action of the objection by the Busselton City community of the City Councils intended relocation of the Historical Busselton War Memorial.

The community wants it known to the Busselton City Council Staff and City councillors that the relocation of this important community owned Historical War Memorial "does not have to be done" and that the expense of moving this memorial is "not warranted" and a waste of City council staff time and of rate payers/stakeholders money as an "unnecessary expense."

Further, the intended relocation/destruction of this memorial is not an "urgent" required City Council infrastructure item such as a Road, Footpath, Drainage item etc., and the intended relocation/destruction of this Historical Heritage Memorial "does not have to be done". That the Community are submitting the enclosed objection Petition that the Busselton City Council and City Councillors "abandon" any further plans and that monies allocated in the budget be put towards the enhancement of the current Historical Heritage structure. Ie; Landscape upgrade by way of new Rose flower Beds, Two extra flag poles and for Floodlighting at night.

Precis; of reasons for maintaining the Historic Heritage Busselton War memorial at its present site

The Current location is a historic heritage high profile 100 year location. The
intended location of Rotary park is an inferior site being the old city council rubbish
tip and will be out of sight out of mind.



- 2. Moving the memorial the Historic structure and integrity of the memorial will be lost and any new structure will have no significance history or heritage value.
- 3. Traffic at the present location traffic has been reduced by up to 60% according to the City of Busselton due to the Eastern Link. Traffic in the present vicinity is passive traffic as it is controlled by traffic lights bringing traffic to a controlled slow quiet stop. Rotary Park is bounded by the Eastrern Link and Causeway road. Both fast flow traffic roads and will be noisy. Access to Rotary Park will be dangerous as the Causeway road has fast traffic flow making access difficult and dangerous for vehicle and pedestrians.
- 4. Moving the memorial for parking and toilet facilities does not warrant relocation as at last ANZAC ceremony 2022 there was an attendance of 5000 community members who found easy access to parking and toilet facilities in the vicinity. The small car park at Rotary park would be inadequate.
- 5. Location of any new structure being near to the RSL facilities is inconsequential as the RSL facilities are a 250mtrs further on and over the opposite side of the Causeway Road.
- 6. The Current location site has dais facilities for dignitaries.

There are other issues with the Rotary Park site which need to be looked at as well and these need further investigation and advice to be obtained.

Requesting this petition be recorded and actioned in accordance with the City of Busselton Protocol.
