Landscape Design and Drawing Approval

Once the Western Australian Planning Commission has approved your subdivision you will be required to demonstrate compliance with the conditions which are to be cleared by this Local Government.

WAPC issues Subdivision Approval Subject to Conditions

Use 'Landscape Planning and Design Checklist' to prepare and then submit landscaping documents required for the City to review and approve



Submit drawings in a digital format (.pdf) to city@busselton.wa.gov.au and a hardcopy of the documents, posted to : 2 Southern Drive, Busselton, WA 6280



City of Busselton staff will check drawings and documents for compliance with City Policies and Section 9(a) and 9(g) of our Engineering Technical Standards & Specifications and provide preliminary feedback



Where changes are required, the City will liaise with the Landscape Consultant



Once drawings and documents are compliant, the City endorses the Landscape Drawings



Developer to provide estimated construction costs and programme for the completion of landscaping works along with annual maintenance cost schedule to the City



Implementation and Maintenance Bonds, Supervision fees and Legal Agreements will now be required. Once finalised, landscaping works can start on site.
