## Queen Street Upgrade

As a part of the continued upgrade of Queen Street, the Council has funding allocated for the upgrade of kerbing, drainage, and paving along Queen Street between Prince Street and Kent Street, Busselton.

### The Stage 1 upgrade works will include:

- New kerbing along both edges of the roadway including brick paved islands
- Gravel (ochre) coloured asphalt in parking bays
- New brick paving of footpath areas
- Upgrade of drainage connections from adjacent buildings to Council drainage system
- Provision of upgraded street furniture including seats and bins

### Stage 2 of the works will include:

- Intersection treatment works at Prince and Queen Street following the council meeting outcome on 13 May 2009
- Stage 1 works will commence on Monday, 4 May 2009 with the majority of works taking place in May (following school holidays) and June 2009.

### Stage 2 works will commence following the council resolution on 13 May 2009.

Whilst the works are being carried out Shire staff will endeavour to provide access past and around the worksite where permissible, to minimise business disruptions. However road closures will be in place from time to time and motorists and pedestrians are advised to abide by the worksite signage, as parking and pedestrian disruptions will be unavoidable.

Shire staff will endeavour to notify adjacent business proprietors when disruptions to parking and pedestrian traffic are imminent.

## Local Government Act 1995

### Shire Of Busselton Proposed Local Government Property Local Law

Notice is hereby given under section 3.12(3) that the Shire of Busselton proposes to make a local law relating to local government property the purpose and effect of which is as follows:

**Purpose:** To regulate the care, control and management of all property of the local government except thoroughfares.

**Effect:** To control the use of local government property. Some activities are permitted only under a permit or under a determination and some activities are restricted or prohibited. Offences are created for inappropriate behaviour in or on local government property.

A copy of the proposed local law may be inspected and a copy obtained at the Shire Offices, Southern Drive, Busselton between the hours of 8.30am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday and at any public library within the Shire of Busselton during normal opening hours.

Submissions about the proposed local law will be received by the Chief Executive Officer, Southern Drive, Busselton, until no later than **Wednesday, 17 June 2009**.
