Notice is hereby given that the local government of the Shire of Busselton has prepared the abovementioned Scheme Amendment for the purpose of:

Rezoning Lot 3, Diagram 80511, Broadhurst Road, Metricup from 'Agriculture' to 'Bushland Protection'. The primary intent of the rezoning is to facilitate subdivision of the subject land consistent with the voluntary subdivision incentive available under the Shire of Busselton Biodiversity Incentive Strategy (BIS).

Plans and documents setting out and explaining the Scheme Amendment have been deposited at the Shire Offices, Southern Drive Busselton and will be available for inspection during office hours up to and including 4 September 2009.

Submissions on the Scheme Amendment may be made in writing on Form No. 4 and lodged with the Chief Executive Officer, Shire of Busselton, Locked Bag 1, Busselton WA 6280 on or before 4 September 2009.

This amendment is available for inspection in order to provide an opportunity for public comment and it should not be construed that final approval will be granted.

'BSN', 'DUNS' & 'YALL' NUMBER PLATES

Looking for that something different for a gift?

The Shire has reviewed the special series plate for the 'Shire of Busselton', encompassing the BSN, DUNS & YALL vehicle number plate designs.

The BSN plate now displays the new Shire logo. As this plate is a revamp of the old plate, the numbers available are limited to those remaining for sale under the old BSN plate design. BSN plates are available for \$535/set.

The DUNS & YALL plate designs remain the same, however are now manufactured from polycarbonate and are now available with 3 digit numbers. Prices start at \$535/set. As this is considered to be a plate revamp, 2 digit numbers on aluminium plates previously sold will not be available for reissue.

WEIGHBRIDGE AT DUNSBOROUGH WASTE FACILITY

Please be advised that from 1 August 2009, the weighbridge at the Dunsborough Waste Facility will be in operation. All commercial waste will be charged by weight from that date. The following fees inclusive of GST, as advertised in the Council's Fees and Charges for 2009/2010, will apply (per 100kg, or part thereof):

General Waste \$2.50	Building Waste \$2.50
Clean Green Waste \$2.50	Contaminated Green Waste \$3.30
Liquid Waste \$3.80	Asbestos \$9.90
Bricks and Concrete \$1.00	Clean Fill no charge
Minimum Weighbridge Charge \$11.00	

Staff reserve the right to apply contaminated green waste fees to loads containing green waste which are not suitable for mulching; general waste fees to loads of bricks and concrete which are contaminated by other products, and general waste fees to loads of clean fill which are not suitable for use as cover material.

USE OF REFLECTIVE BUILDING MATERIALS

The Shire is seeking your comment on its policies relating to the use of building materials, in particular roofs, which complement the environment in terms of colour and texture, and do not cause glare or excessive reflectance.

Over the last two decades the Shire has had a policy of not supporting the use of highly reflective building materials such as zinc-metal coated and "off white" colour bonded roofing. The Shire is reviewing this policy to determine: its continued relevance; its need for enhancement in respect to thermal efficiency of certain lighter coloured roofing products; and what colours and materials are appropriate.

A 'Discussion Paper' is available which sets out and explains some of the key issues relating to reducing reflectance and glare from building materials and sets out some general policy conclusions. To view this paper, click onto www.busselton.wa.gov.au

FUNDING SCHEME

Community Sporting & Recreational Facilities Fund 2009/10 Small Grants Round and 2010/11 Round Now Open

The Department of Sport and Recreation seeks applications from incorporated, not for profit community groups for financial support through the Community Sport and Recreation Facilities Fund for the following types of projects:

1. Small Grants (Projects up to \$150,000 of which up to \$50,000 can be provided through this scheme). There are two rounds for this scheme now open, with the first round to be acquitted by 30 June 2010.
2. Annual Grants (Projects up to \$500,000 of which up to \$166,667 can be provided through this scheme).
3. Forward Planning Grants (Projects in excess of \$500,000 of which in excess of \$166,667 can be provided through this scheme).
