- 5.1. The City is committed to:
 - a. the proactive management of City land to protect and enhance environmental values;
 - b. the establishment and maintenance of effective working relationships and partnerships with the community and other stakeholders to undertake environmental management;
 - c. decision-making which gives due regard to environmental values alongside economic and social considerations.
- 5.2. The City will ensure its decision making considers potential impacts on the environment by integrating environmental protection, social advancement and economic prosperity principles within sound governance frameworks.

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- 5.3. The City will implement management and operational practices which are considerate of the environmental values of the District, minimise waste and resource consumption and protect the City's exceptionally high biodiversity values.
- 5.4. The City will maintain an Environment Strategy to provide strategic direction and to guide the City's environmental management activities.
- 5.5. The City will build and maintain community capacity and engagement in relation to environmental management through:
 - a. encouraging and supporting community participation and inclusiveness;
 - b. promoting community engagement and collaboration;
 - c. encouraging and nurturing partnerships.
