Bus logistic officer

Can be any age.

Someone who does not want to on the fire hose but wishes to still be involved.

Will need to be able to receive emails or texts with lists of fire crew that are being deployed on the bus out of the city eg Bridgetown etc

Duty will be to check all those on the list are on the bus (could be midnight or 5am or mis afternoon. This varies) Go with the bus to the fire ground and check all the crew returning are present and accounted for. Return on the bus with the tired crews.

It may be necessary to source food from the canteen at fire ground for any members late back to rendezvous point. This hurry's up the return of the bus to Busselton.

Ideally we would like 5 or 6 of these logistic officers from within the 14 brigades so that they don't get worn out.

Brigade contact for deployment crews

This can be someone that wishes to be involved but not wanting to go onto the fire ground.

Jane Guthrie will contact this person when a request for crews to be deployed to outside the shire occurs. The brigade contact then contacts their own brigade and finds replacement crews. Then reports Name, dietary issues and phone numbers to Jane. Once it is confirmed that crews are to go time will be given to brigade coordinator and that person will advise the members where and what time they need to go. This process can roll on over a couple of days.
