#### 5. POLICY STATEMENT

- 5.1. The City's environment is core to its vision to be a place where environment, lifestyle and opportunity thrive.
- 5.2. The City is also committed to upholding the requirements of the *Local Government Act 1995* (WA) and recognises its responsibility to demonstrate leadership and work with community by delivering governance excellence leading towards an integrated environmentally, socially, and economically sustainable future.
- 5.3. The Local Government Act 1995 (WA) Section 3.1(1A) states:

Without limiting subsection (1), the general function of a local government must be performed having regard to the following:

# (a) the need:

- (i) to promote the economic, social, and environmental sustainability of the district; and
- (ii) to plan for, and to plan for mitigating, risks associated with climate change; and
- (iii) in making decisions, to consider potential long-term consequences and impacts on future generations

# 5.4. The City of Busselton is committed to:

- a. Promoting sustainable management practices across City operations through effective organisational leadership and governance.
- b. Considering and balancing environmental, social, economic and governance impacts when making decisions.
- c. Considering ways to deliver beneficial environmental, social and economic outcomes through strategic procurement approaches.
- d. Empowering City employees to approach challenges and opportunities sustainably by providing a Sustainability and Environment Framework.
- e. Collaborating with key stakeholders including local, state and federal governments, research institutions, non-government organisations, industry and advocacy bodies, and the business community to achieve shared sustainability objectives and environmental resilience.
- f. Promoting sustainable management, conservation and enhancement of the City's natural environment in a way that maintains ecological integrity and recognising that the South West Region is located within one of the 36 internationally recognised biodiversity hotspots around the world.
- g. Promoting sustainable management, conservation and enhancement of the City's built environment and heritage.
- h. Building, maintaining, improving and operating City facilities and assets to ensure operational efficiency and to maximise energy and water savings.
- i. Promoting sustainable practices and building resilience within the local community through fostering a shared understanding and collective responsibility.
- j. Supporting an equitable, inclusive, and sustainable local economy.
- k. Embracing and supporting innovation, industry leadership and opportunities for continual improvement by adopting a progressive and agile approach.
