H5 Bird Flu - Keep up to date

Together we can prepare to better protect our community, wildlife, and farms from H5 bird flu which has now been detected in wild seabirds in Western Australia. While the risk to the public remains low, it is a timely reminder of how connected we are to the health of our local environment.

The best thing we can do is stay informed, follow official advice and continue to protect our health, our pets, our farms, and wildlife within the community.

How community can help:

- **Avoid** contact with sick or dead wildlife and their environment. Do not allow pets to touch or eat sick or dead wildlife.
- **Record** what you see, the location the animal was found, and take photos or video if safe to do so.
- **Report** unusual sickness or multiple deaths in wildlife via the **Emergency Animal Disease Hotline on 1800 675 888.**

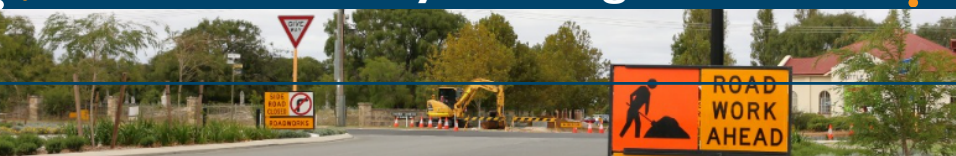

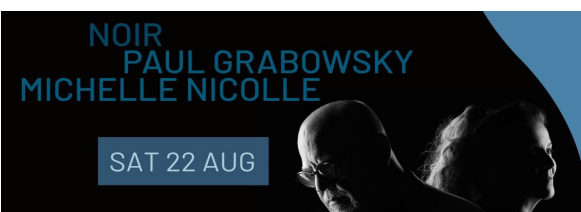
