Simple steps you can make to help protect yourself, your loved ones and your home:

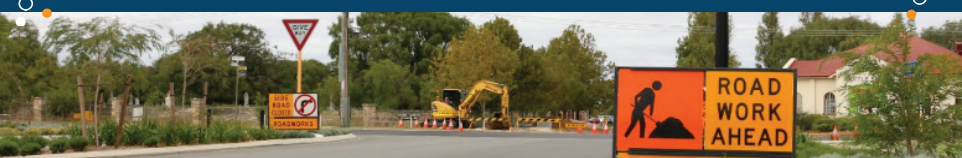
- Keep items at least one metre from heaters.
