Project updates

DA26/0209 - Industry - Extractive (Sand) - Lot 4 (No. 2774) Caves Road Yallingup

Public consultation for DA26/0209 - Industry - Extractive (Sand) - Lot 4 (No. 2774) Caves Road Yallingup ran from Friday 15 May 2026 to Friday 12 June 2026, with more than 2,350 submissions received, reflecting strong community interest in the application.

The City has referred the proposal to the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) under section 38 of the Environmental Protection Act 1986 (EP Act). All referred proposals are published for a 7-day public comment period on whether the EPA should assess a proposal and why. The EPA will review the relevant information and determine whether or not to assess the proposal, and if so, the level of assessment. The EPA decision on whether to assess a proposal is based on whether the proposal is likely to have a significant impact or impacts on the environment that warrant assessment under Part IV of the EP Act, and whether those impacts could be mitigated to be consistent with the EPA objectives.

Any decision on the development application by the Development Assessment Panel (DAP) will be deferred until after the EPA undertakes its assessment. Once the EPA process is finalised, City officers will prepare a report for the DAP.

DO NOT move wood or plants from the Perth metro area. Polyphagous-shot-hole-borer (PSHB) does not move far on its own but can travel long distances when people move firewood or plants.

Save our south west trees! This beetle is highly invasive and attacks a wide range of plant species.

Keep your birds safe

A serious strain of H5 avian influenza (bird flu) has spread quickly overseas due to migrating wild birds. Act now to protect your backyard poultry and kept birds.



Keep wild birds away from your birds by using housing and netting

Keep bird feed and water in an area that wild birds can't access



Keep poultry coops, aviaries and equipment clean

Keep new birds quarantined before integrating them with your flock



Keep up your hand hygiene - wash hands with soap before and after handling birds and eggs.

Keep watch for signs of sick birds. Report groups of sick or dead birds to your local vet or the Emergency Animal Disease hotline on **1800 675 888**.
