Notice of a proposal to permanently close portion of Port Lane, Geographe

Pursuant to the *Land Administration Act 1997*, the City invites
submissions to a proposal to permanently close a portion of public road.
Referring to the map, an approximate 276m² portion of **Port Lane,
Geographe**, is proposed to be closed. Should the road closure proceed
in accordance with the Act, it is proposed the road land is amalgamated
with adjoining property.

Please note that the area of road proposed to be closed is road verge
only and does not affect the roadway or any constructed footpath.
