The City of Busselton has received an application to use and/or develop land for the following purposes and public comments are invited.

Property: 2 Grace Court West Busselton WA
Proposed Development: Educational Establishment (Additional Classrooms)

The proposal includes the following:

- A 2-storey building comprising of 8 classrooms, resulting in an increase from 33 classrooms to 41 classrooms on site.
- A floor area of 560m² per level.
- A building height of 9m above Natural Ground Level.
- A new pedestrian access point to Waratah Court.
- Removal of 17 trees.

Causeway Road Bridge (over the Vasse River) - Load and Speed Limit Changes

The City has been directed by Main Roads WA to introduce new traffic restrictions on the Causeway Road bridge which crosses the Vasse River.

Following a structural assessment by Main Roads WA, the following changes have now been implemented:

1. **Load limit reduced to 12 tonnes** (regular cars, utes and SUVs can still use the bridge)
2. **Only northbound traffic** (traffic heading into town) will be permitted to use the bridge via a single lane
3. **Speed limit to be reduced to 40km/h**

For the limited number of heavy vehicles that travel on this section of Causeway Road, there will be detours via alternative routes, including Cammilleri Street, Peel Terrace, Strelly Street and Barlee/West Street. New traffic controls and signage will be in place to guide road users.

The Causeway Road bridge is a City of Busselton asset with inspections, maintenance and works undertaken in partnership with Main Roads WA through State Government funded bridge programs.

The City is now working with Main Roads WA to plan for and undertake repairs to reinstate bridge load limits to meet current Main Roads WA specifications. Approvals from relevant agencies are required before works can commence, so at this stage we anticipate repairs to be completed in 3-4 months.

Applications are invited from Sporting Clubs requiring the use of City reserves, including hard courts during the 2026/2027 Summer Season (early October 2026 to late March 2027).

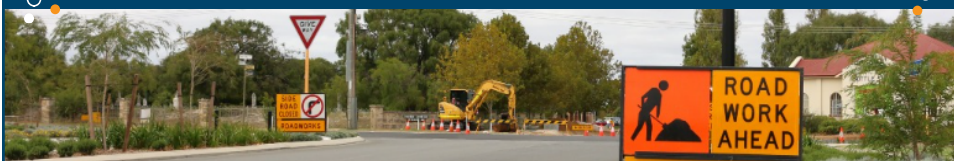

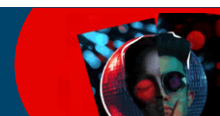
