

As of 1 January 2026, the CEO is required to maintain and publish on the City's website an up to date record of information relating to matters prescribed under section 5.96C of the *Local Government Act 1995*:

5.96C Record of Information about conduct

(1) *The CEO must maintain a record of information about the following —*

- (a) *behavioural breaches by a council member that are found under the local government's code of conduct to have occurred;*
- (b) *recurrent breaches that are found under section 8A.14(4) to have been committed by a council member;*
- (c) *conduct breaches by a council member that are found under section 8A.18 to have occurred;*
- (d) *specified breaches that are found under section 8A.25 to have been committed by a council member;*
- (e) *orders made under section 8A.14(5), 8A.18(4), 8A.21(2)(b), 8A.25 or 8A.27(2)(b) in respect of a council member;*
- (f) *any other prescribed information about the conduct of a person who is, or of a person when they were, a council member, the CEO or another employee.*

(2) *In subsection (1)(a) to (e), references to a council member include a former council member.*

(3) *The CEO must publish an up-to-date version of the record of information on the local government's official website.*

Behavioural Breaches

A Behavioural Breach occurs when a council member is found to have breached a requirement referred to in Division 3 of the City of Busselton Code of Conduct for Council members, Committee Members and Candidates.

Conduct Breaches

A Conduct Breach occurs when a council member is found to have breached a requirement referred to in Division 4 of the City of Busselton Code of Conduct for Council members, Committee Members and Candidates, or a local law made under the *Local Government Act 1995* which regulations specify to be a Conduct Breach.

A Recurrent Breach occurs when a council member is found to have committed a Conduct Breach after having committed two or more other Conduct

A Specified Breach occurs when a council member is found to have committed an offence specified in Schedule 8.1A of the *Local Government Act 1995*, or an offence under a written law (other than a local law made under the *Local Government Act 1995*) that is prescribed to be a specified offence.
