NO FIRES IN THE OPEN DURING PROHIBITED BURNING TIMES!

FIRES IN THE OPEN INCLUDE

CAMPING AND / OR COOKING FIRES
FIRE PITS
CHIMINEAS
BRAZIERS

NO FIRES ON PUBLIC LAND INCLUDING BEACHES AT ANY TIME

- Prohibited Burning Times 1 December to 28 February each year (dates subject to change without notice.
- No fires in the open any time of the year when the Fire Danger Rating is High or above or when there is a Total Fire Ban.
- ✓ Gas BBQs and pizza ovens are permitted.

HOW TO BE SAFE WHEN FIRES ARE PERMITTED

- ✓ Don't light a fire if the weather is hot, dry and windy.
- ✓ Before you light anything up look around and think about the risk. A small fire is big enough!
- ✓ Ensure all vegetation and flammable materials are cleared at least 3m from around the fire site.
- ✓ Never leave your fire unattended and extinguish it with water before you leave.
