Engineering Drawing Approval

Once the Western Australian Planning Commission has approved your subdivision you will be required to demonstrate compliance with the conditions which are to be cleared by this Local Government.

Use this flowchart to get your engineering drawings approved before starting works on site.

WAPC issues Subdivision Approval Subject to Conditions

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Use 'Development Control Compliance Checklist 1' to prepare and then submit documents required for the City to review and approve

City of Busselton staff will check drawings and documents for compliance with relevant standards, guidlines and our Engineering Technical Standards & Specifications and provide preliminary feedback



Where changes are required, the City will liaise with the Engineering Consultant



Once drawings and documents are compliant, the City issues an approval letter allowing works to start. 'Hold Points' are identified which require City inspection. Supervision fees and bonds may also be payable
