

# A-Z Waste & Recycling guide



● Put in your yellow Recycling bin

● Put in your red or green General waste bin

● Drop off to the Busselton Transfer Station or the Vidler Road Landfill

- A**
- Aluminium cans\*\*
  - Aluminium foil
  - Animal droppings
  - Appliances (i.e. fridges, stoves, toasters)
  - Ash (cold)

- B**
- Baking paper
  - Batteries
  - Beer bottles and cans\*\*
  - Biscuit trays
  - Books
  - Bread tags
  - Broken toys
  - Bubble wrap\*
  - Building materials (e.g. timber, tiles and tin etc.)

- C**
- Cables, cords, rope
  - Car batteries
  - Cardboard (clean)
  - Cartons – milk and juice\*\* (flattened and not silver lined)

- C**
- Cartons – milk and juice (silver lined)
  - Cellophane\*
  - Cereal box liners\*
  - Chemicals and cleaning products
  - Chip and snack food packets\*
  - Cigarette butts
  - Cling wrap\*
  - Clothing (unsaleable)
  - Coffee cups and lids
  - Coffee pods
  - Computers and accessories
  - Crockery and ceramics
  - Cutlery (steel and plastic)

- E**
- Egg cartons
  - E-waste (e.g. Computers, TVs, printers and peripherals)
  - Envelopes (including window-faced)

- F**
- Fabric
  - Flowers and dead plants
  - Foam
  - Foil lined packets\*
  - Foil
  - Food pouches\*
  - Food scraps
  - Fruit and vegetable scraps (all)
  - Furniture

- G**
- Garden trimmings
  - Garden waste (bulk)
  - Gas bottles
  - Glass jars and bottles\*\*
  - Glass plates/Pyrex/mirror glass
  - Grass clippings

- H**
- Hair
  - Hose and pipe

- J**
- Juice boxes (silver lined)
  - Junk mail (paper)

- K**
- Kitty litter

\*Soft plastics can be dropped off at Coles and Woolworths for recycling in the REDcycle Program.  
\*\*Items may be eligible for the Container Deposit Scheme. Please refer to images on the other side.

- L**
- Laminated paper
  - Leaves
  - Lids (metal or larger than a credit card)
  - Lids (plastic and smaller than a credit card)
  - Light globes and fluorescent tubes
  - Lighters

- M**
- Magazines
  - Manure
  - Mattresses
  - Meat trays
  - Medicine bottles
  - Mesh and netting
  - Mobile phones and chargers
  - Motor oil

- N**
- Nappies
  - Newspapers

- O**
- Office paper
  - Oil (motor only) <20 litres

- P**
- Paint Tins
  - Paper (clean and dry)
  - Paper towel (used)
  - Pens, markers and pencils
  - Pet waste
  - Pill packets (empty)
  - Pizza boxes (clean)
  - Plastic Australia Post Satchels\*
  - Plastic bags and soft plastic\*
  - Plastic containers and bottles\*\*
  - Plastic cups, plates and cutlery
  - Plastic fruit punnets (strawberries, tomatoes, etc.)
  - Plastic plant pots
  - Polystyrene Foam
  - Printer cartridges

- R**
- Rubber bands

- S**
- Sanitary items
  - Seafood
  - Serviettes and napkins
  - Shoes (damaged)
  - Shredded paper
  - Soil (small amounts only)
  - Steel tins and cans
  - Straws
  - String and twine

- T**
- Takeaway 100% compostable/ BioPak containers and cups
  - Takeaway containers (hard plastic only)
  - Takeaway foam containers and cups
  - Tea bags
  - Telephone books
  - Timber
  - Tissues
  - Tins (i.e. tuna)
  - Toilet rolls
  - Toothpaste tubes
  - Tyres

- U**
- Used tissues and paper

- V**
- Vacuum cleaner dust
  - Vinyl (e.g. school bags)

- W**
- Wallpaper
  - Waxed paper
  - Weeds
  - White Goods
  - Wine bottles
  - Wine casks (bladders)
  - Wipes
  - Wrapping paper

- X**
- X-ray films

- Y**
- Yogurt pouches\*
  - Yogurt containers (rinsed)

Gas bottles, paint, batteries and motor oil must not go in kerbside bins. Please take these to the Busselton Transfer Station or the Vidler Road Landfill.

Electronic waste, appliances and globes must not go in kerbside bins. Please take these items to your nearest drop off facility.
