It is the pool owner's responsibility to ensure that the pool (including the barriers for the pool) is properly maintained at all times to comply with the pool safety standards. The legislative framework that mandates this requirement in Western Australia comprises of; the Building Act 2011 (WA) (the Act); the Building Regulations 2012 (WA) (the Regulations); Australian Standard AS 1926.1-2012 and Australian Standard AS 1926.2-2012. High penalties apply for noncompliance.
