HOW YOUR WASTE IS RECYCLED THROUGH THE CITY OF BUSSELTON

The City of Busselton uses a contractor to collect the recyclable materials from your yellow-top bin, sort them by type (ie. paper, plastic, steel), sell the materials and transport them to manufacturers for recycling in order to make new products. Most of the materials are exported for recycling, however, glass is crushed and used in road base construction.

We encourage our residents to separate and clean all items which can be recycled to help the City divert as much waste from landfill as possible and in turn reduce our impact on the environment.
